**10:00-10:30** Flight over Fort Collins and Loveland

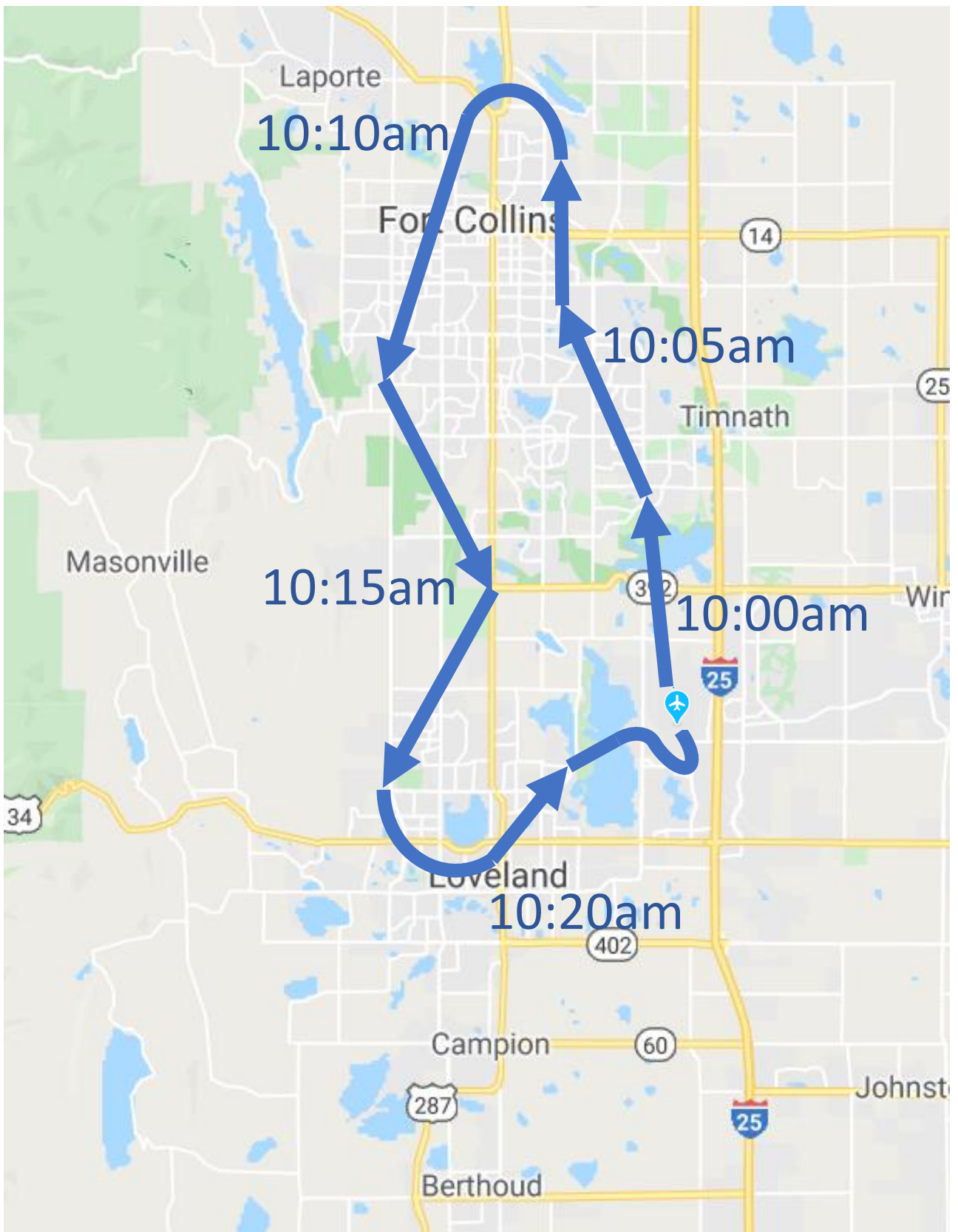
